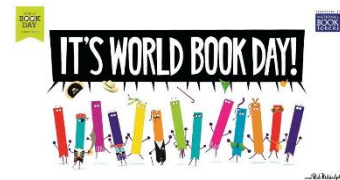
Pancake Day – Shrove Tuesday – 4th March
